DANCE CLASSES FOR 2025 & HOW TO RE-ENROL

Please let Mrs Bennett know (<u>bennettballetandjazz@xtra.co.nz</u>) by <u>Monday 2 December 2024</u> if your child is returning to the Dance School in 2025 so that a place for them will be guaranteed. If you have not contacted Mrs Bennett by 2 December, your child's place may be given to another student and then if your child does want to return they may need to go on a waiting list.

<u>Please do not simply turn up to class next year without enrolling your child as you may discover that the class is full and your child cannot be accommodated.</u>

Any seniors who would like to discuss their dance programme for next year, please contact Mrs Bennett after the show.

The full timetable for 2025 classes has been emailed to everyone as a separate attachment along with this notice, as well as the 2025 BSBJ Handbook which includes the fees for 2025, as well as lots of other important information about the dance school and dance classes.

In addition, there's a table on the following page that lists the classes (Grade 5 and below) that were offered this year and shows which class each of these leads to next year. Please note the following:

- Ballet classes from Primary upwards and Jazz classes from Grade 1 upwards are 1 hour long (rather than 45 minutes).
- Students in Ballet classes from Grade 2 upwards must attend 2 classes per week if they intend to sit exams. Once children reach certain levels in dance, the amount of work and technicality increases. Consequently, attendance at more classes is required to further develop technique and strength so that female students can eventually work in pointe shoes and male students have the strength and stamina needed for boys'/men's work. However, students may choose to attend only 1 class per week if they do not want to sit exams but would like to continue with their dancing simply for enjoyment.
- Students in Jazz classes from Grade 6 upwards must attend 2 classes per week if they intend to sit exams.

Mrs Bennett will talk with students in Grade 5 and above regarding their class options for next year.

In 2025 classes will start on <u>Monday 27 January</u>. There will not be classes on Thursday 6 February 2025 as the dance school will be observing the Waitangi Day public holiday on this day.

Along with the performance experience that comes with competing, students learn many new skills being part of a troupe, including working together as a team, improved timing and musicality and better spatial awareness.

If you're interested in your child attending this class, there are a few standards your child must meet:

- Your child must learn ballet and jazz with us at the Bennett School of Ballet & Jazz.
- This class costs \$175.00 per term over and above your child's other term fees at the dance school. Please note that this fee does not include the cost of costumes see below.
- Costumes will be an additional cost (approximately \$120.00 per costume to purchase maybe more
 or less depending on what is available, exchange rates and custom/tax duties or \$15 per costume
 hired from BSBJ).

At the beginning of next year, please feel free to bring in any secondhand dance clothes or shoes that you would like to sell as these are always in great demand particularly at the start of the year. Put each piece of clothing or pair of shoes into a plastic bag with your name and the price on the outside and then put them on the sale table in the Dressing Room. If you are selling shoes, please just put one shoe on the table and give the other shoe (labelled with your name) to Mrs Bennett for safe keeping in the office.
